Sirius Cove Nursing Home is a two level 55 bed residential aged care facility. There is stair and lift access between the floors and because of the slope of the land, each floor has level access to the street.

Admission to Sirius Cove is by approval of the Commonwealth Department of Health and Ageing, via your local Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT). The Team will provide you with a copy of the approval, known as an ACCR Form.

The Commonwealth Department of Health and Ageing also determines the fees and basic benefit paid for each resident. Information about the current level of fees may be obtained from the Director of Nursing.

Sirius Cove offers a wide range of services, delivered by suitably qualified and professional staff.

Thirteen single rooms and thirteen multi-bed rooms are available.

An extensive activities programme is offered, designed to promote quality of life and entertainment for the residents.



ACTIVITIES PROGRAMME

Our therapy team co-ordinates a comprehensive and creative activities programme.
